I am directed to invite your kind attention on the subject noted above and to say that in order to reduce the telephone charges the state had adopted by this CUG scheme of BSNL in 2009. The scheme was widely advertised by the office letter No.31/1/2009-11A dated 15.6.2009 and subsequent reminders thereof. It was observed that a very few Departments /Boards/ Corporations adopted the scheme. On further study in the matter it was felt that the desired response to the scheme was not obtained because of the lengthy and cumbersome process of dialing of the number by prefixing #1 followed by a specific code number, and the STD code of the called number, even within the city.


After much deliberation the BSNL has agreed to simplify the scheme, and now the users adopting the scheme will only have to register themselves under the scheme. The dialing process will be the same as being used commonly. The main benefit of the scheme is that there would be no local/ STD charges within the city/ districts of Haryana and Chandigarh. The calls made to other phones not registered under the scheme would be charged as per the existing tariff. The monthly plan charges under the scheme is Rs. 299/-.

It is, therefore, requested that the Departments/Boards/Corporations under your kind control may be directed to register themselves under this scheme with their respective Telephone Exchanges. If there is any difficulty they may contact Sh.J.C.Gupta, DGM(F&A) o/o CGMT, BSNL, Haryana, 107, The Mall Ambala Cantt(Mobile 09416011660), the Nodal Authority declared by BSNL in this case. It is also requested that your subordinate offices may review their bills after a period of two months of the adoption of the scheme, and send a detailed report of the increase and decrease in their bills for the

period to this office please. The list of numbers already in this scheme can be downloaded from the Haryana Govt. website haryana.gov.in .

A separate Directory will be published after a considerable number of telephones are registered, under this scheme.


