Subject: **Non payment of electricity bills by AP consumers – disconnection thereof.**

Rural consumers of AP & DS categories were not making the payment of their electricity bills since long and crores of Rs. were accumulated as arrears of the Nigam against such consumers. The Govt. of Haryana decided/approved a scheme for the settlement of accumulated arrears (Waiver Scheme) of rural domestic and agriculture categories of consumers and the compliance of the same were required by Power Utilities. Accordingly DHBVN had issued a circular D-8/2005 dated 20.6.05 for implementation of the settlement scheme. The scheme was valid upto 31.7.05. The scheme was extended further vide various circulars latest vide circular SI/07/2007 dated 25.1.07 valid upto 28.2.07 so that more and more rural defaulting consumers may take the benefit by opting for the scheme which has since expired.

It has been observed that inspite of repeated extensions of the settlement scheme (Waiver Scheme) only about 80% defaulting consumers of AP category had opted for the scheme till 31st March 2007 and the balance are still the defaulters.

From the above it is clear that these balance defaulting consumers are not interested to opt for the scheme and regularize their tubewell connection. Since the tubewell lines are existing near their tubewell premises, they may be running their tubewells illegally at any time by theft of energy which will cause heavy revenue loss to the Nigam.

As such it has become necessary to check the nefarious activities of such AP consumers who have not joined the arrear waiver scheme so far. Therefore in view of the fact that balance defaulting AP consumers have not joined/opted for the arrear waiver scheme therefore, to avoid theft of electric energy by them the Nigam shall remove the existing line from their premises to avoid further revenue loss to the Nigam.

Accordingly it is directed as below:

Each AGM (OP) S/Divn. Under DHBVN shall disconnect one No. defaulting AP consumer's premises per week who has not opted for the arrear scheme till 31st March 2007. He shall ensure the removal of all line material and

transformer etc. providing supply to that premises. The AGM concerned will furnish the certificate to the DGM (OP) that the premises of defaulting consumer (by mentioning the complete detail) have been disconnected by him and all material/equipment have been removed.

The above instruction shall be applicable with immediate effect. The CGM/GM/DGM (OP) shall direct all the field offices under their kind jurisdiction to comply with the above instruction meticulously with immediate effect other wise action shall be initiated.

The G.M. (OP) will furnish the consolidated fortnightly progress report of their circle on the following performa.
