Subject: Power subsidy scheme of Rs.2/- per unit for all industrial connections in 'C' & 'D' category blocks of the State with a connected load of 20 KW or less.

Please refer to the Sales Circular No. D-31/2018 dated 14/12/2018 vide which the Distribution and Retail Supply Tariff for FY 2018-19 w.e.f 01/11/2018 has been made applicable to the electricity consumers in UHBVN and DHBVN.

The State Govt. vide Power Department Notification No.23/24/2018-3P dated 21/12/2018 (copy enclosed) has decided to grant a subsidy of Rs.2/- per unit in the applicable tariff on consumption w.e.f. 1st November, 2018 to all industrial connections in 'C' & 'D' category blocks of the state, having connected load of 20 KW or less.

In view of the above, the billing agencies shall ensure that the bills to be issued to the aforesaid consumers shall clearly depict the following: -

- (i) Bill amount without subsidy
- (ii) Amount of subsidy to be given by the Govt. of Haryana and
- (iii) The net bill amount payable.

The above instructions should be brought to the notice of all concerned for careful and meticulous compliance with immediate effect.

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And whereas, it has been decided by the State Government in the Industries Department to grant a subsidy of Rs 2 per unit in the tariff applicable to industrial connections in C and D category blocks of the State, with a connected load of 20kW or less, as per provisions of Section 65 of Electricity Act 2003 w.e.f. 1st November 2018, whereby the revenue loss to the Discoms shall be compensated by the Government by way of advance payment of subsidy;

And whereas, under section 108 of the Electricity Act 2003, which is reproduced below, the State Government has the powers to issue direction to the State Commission in case of matters pertaining to public interest.

"Section 108. Directions by State Government: ---

- (1) In the discharge of its functions, the State Commission shall be guided by such directions in matters of policy involving public interest as the State Government may give to it in writing.
- (2) If any question arises as to whether any such direction relates to a matter of policy involving public interest, the decision of the State Government thereon shall be final."

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Now, therefore, in consideration of the position as brought out above and in exercise of powers conferred under section 108 sub-section (1) read with section 65 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (No.36 of 2003), the Haryana Govt, hereby issues directive as under:-

- All Industrial connections in 'C' and 'D' category blocks of the State, having a connected load of 20kW or less, shall be granted a subsidy of Rs 2 per unit in the applicable tariff on consumption w.e.f. 1st November 2018.
- The State Commission shall grant necessary approval for grant of subsidy of Rs 2 per unit in the applicable tariff to all Industrial connections in 'C' and 'D' category blocks of the State, with a connected load of 20kW or less on consumption w.e.f 1st November, 2018. Quantum impact of the above tariff subsidy shall be paid to the UHBVNL and DHBVNL in advance in compliance of the provisions of Section 65 of the Electricity Act, 2003.


It is requested to ensure compliance of these orders.
