**Subject: Issue of Demand Notice to AP applicants.**

A meeting was held on 14/6/2011 under the Chairmanship of FC&PS to the Government of Haryana Power Department vide which the following decisions were taken:-

1. Notices for seeking option/consent for release of tubewell connection under the various options available under modified HVDS scheme be obtained from the consumers whose applications have been received upto 31/12/2010.
2. On receipt of consent and framing of proper estimate, the demand notice be served to the consumer within a time frame of next 3 months.
3. It should be ensured by concerned officer that the connections are released on segregated AP feeders only.
4. Only consumption Security from the AP consumer at the time of receipt of application be accepted in future and the amount towards cost of transformer be taken at the time of issue of demand notice.

In compliance to the decisions taken in the above said meeting, it has been decided that ***the demand notices for pending AP applications received upto 31/12/2010 be issued within three months from the date of issue of this instruction.***

Further it has also been decided by the Nigam that in case of non submission of option / consent by the AP applicant if any, within three months and likewise non compliance of demand notice within three months then such applications shall be cancelled. However SE/OP will be competent to revive such cancelled applications within 12 months of the date of their cancellation.

The above instructions should be brought to the notice of all concerned for careful and meticulous compliance.
