Sub:- Levy of peak load exemption charges for power during peak load hours.

Please refer to this office memo No.-123/GM/C-9/2007 dated 09.08,2012 vide which it was decided that special dispensation above 20% & upto 50% of sanctioned CD shall be allowed by SDO/OP concerned on demand by the consumer. The cases involving special dispensation beyond 50% shall be referred to the office of CE/Commercial, DHBVN, Hisar for its approval and subsequently the Management vide memo No. Ch-133/GM/C-9/2007/S/C dated 14/10/2013 has issued the direction that consumers who have already been allowed 50% of its CD as special dispensation during peak load hours can avail upto 100% of its CD for the period as already allowed to them subject to the terms and conditions already laid down at the time of sanctioning of dispensation up to 50% of CD being power was available at that time.

Now it has decided that henceforth special dispensation beyond 20% & upto 100% will be allowed by the CE/Commercial on demand of consumer through E-mail subject to the terms and conditions given in the SC No.D-30/2013.

The CE/Commercial in turn will consider the consumer request and allow the special dispensation to the extent as asked for by the consumer and confirm to him through return E-mail within 24 hours, special dispensation once allowed shall continue till the same is withdraw / modified by the consumer or the utility.

This supersedes Sale Instruction No. 7/2014.

The above instructions should be brought to the notice of all concerned for careful and meticulous compliance please.
